Each class is fully furnished and caters to the seating capacity of 25 students on an average. The School Management committee comprises of various professionals from different fields who always induce new ideas and concepts while monitoring regular functioning of the school. This committee is headed by Mr. Mahabir Singh Ji who is the chairman of the society. Many other members and representatives form an integral part of this committee. Various SMC decisions have been taken in the past and recent past which were important and lead to the growth of the institution.

Other competitions of Hula Hoop by Hula Hoop Association of Amritsar, Open District Roller Hockey Championship by Goal Bagh Association

were held in which our students came with flying colours. In the field of art, students participated in Pidilite A + Collage and 3D Painting competition where in our students bagged gold and silver medals. Another competition called Camelin Kukoyo Competition was held in which two children brought prizes and certificates. A Face Colouring competition was held at Global Institutes in which one student got a cash prize as well as medal. Apart from these, students took part in Olympiads and have scored appreciable marks in which they were awarded cash prizes, medals, certificates and trophies. In academics, students participated in Spell quest competition, Science Model Making Competition, Elocution Competition and demonstrated full zeal and bagged several prizes.

Many events were held in this academic session. Since many years, we are making our students take the first taste of democracy and leadership qualities through the voting system in Student Council Elections. Elected members got their badges pinned on their Investiture Ceremony. We witnessed a magnanimous evening when Annual Day was celebrated with unprecedented fanfare at the school premises when students gave astounding performances under the theme (The Jungle Feat). Students were taken for many excursions and field trips. They were taken to US (NASA) to see where the technology has reached.
